PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT
STICHTING CONVERIUM SECURITIES COMPENSATION FOUNDATION

The undersigned:

1. a. A. Baladi, residing in (3 Rue Robert de Traz, 1211) Geneva, Switzerland, born in Heliopolis, Cairo, Egypt on 11 March 1934, chairman, and
b. T. Schibler, residing in (3 Passage de l'Intendant, 1227) Carouge, Switzerland, born in Lausanne, Switzerland on 14 May 1965, secretary, or H.A. Groen, residing in (Sir Winston Churchillweg 2, 2251 CX) Voorschoten, Netherlands, born in Amsterdam, Netherlands on 6 August 1941, treasurer,
acting as Members of the Executive Board who are jointly authorized to represent the foundation: "**Stichting Converium Securities Compensation Foundation**", having its registered office and address in The Hague, the Netherlands, hereinafter referred to as: "**the Foundation**".

_____, hereinafter referred to as: "**the Participant**",

whereas,

- a. the Foundation is entering into separate settlement agreements with Converium Holding AG, now known as SCOR Holding AG, and Zurich Financial Services (collectively: the "**Settling Companies**") to resolve all claims relating to the purchase of, or any other investment decision concerning, Converium common stock on the SWX Swiss Exchange during the period from 7 January 2002 through 2 September 2004, by persons or entities who resided outside the United States of America at the time of purchase (the "**Settlement Agreements**");
- b. the Foundation intends to request, jointly with the Settling Companies, the Amsterdam Court of Appeal to declare the Settlement Agreements binding;
- c. the Foundation is authorized, in accordance with the definitions in Article 3 paragraph 2(a) of the Articles of Association of the Foundation (the "**Articles**"), to enter into a Participation Agreement with certain (legal) persons who meet the requirements prescribed by the Articles;
- d. the Participant qualifies as an Investor as referred to in the definitions in Article 1 of the Articles;

having been fully informed of the Articles and the current drafts for the Settlement Agreements;

hereby conclude a participation agreement under the following conditions:

Article 1.

The Participant shall support the Settlement Agreements and supports the intention to file a request with the Amsterdam Court of Appeal under the Dutch Class Action Financial Settlement Act (*Wet Collectieve Afwikkeling Massaschade*) to declare the Settlement Agreements binding.

Article 2.

Upon signing of this Participation Agreement the Participant agrees with and shall comply with the Articles and shall have the rights assigned to Participants in the Articles.

Article 3.

The Participants, Foundation and Members of the Executive Board hereby waive and release each other from any claims, liabilities or obligations that relate in any way to any or all acts, omissions, nondisclosures, facts, matters, transactions, occurrences, oral or written statements, or representations in connection with or directly or indirectly relating to the negotiation, execution or implementation of the Settlement Agreements, except in case of gross negligence or wilful misconduct.

Article 4.

Dutch law will apply to this Participation Agreement. Any action arising under or to enforce this Participation Agreement shall be commenced and maintained only in the District Court in The Hague (Netherlands).
